Layout Description:

The transom of the boat supports heavy duty davits and, on the inside of the aft cockpit, the stern bench seat also provides functional storage. The helm is positioned on the Port side, with easy to read instruments, and served by matching pilot and co-pilot's seats. A pram hood and folding screens provide all - weather protection when required. Steps lead down from the cockpit into the saloon which accommodates, to port, a comfortable 4 seater dinette, which converts to a double berth, and directly opposite is the attractive timber-clad galley unit. Amidships on the Port Side is a three quarter wardrobe opposite to which is the toilet and shower compartment which houses, in its timber clad construction, a hinged panel that separates the saloon from the forward cabin for overnight privacy. The forward cabin has two v-berths, with infill to convert to a double, with storage below these bunks and an escape hatch, above, set in the foredeck
